Excerpt from "Birding in Eastham, Cape Cod"






Descending the stairs to the beach, there were promising compositions with the cliffs, beach and ocean waves breaking on the beach. One, in particular, almost has a painterly effect as I looked at it afterwards. The water marks on the sand, people in the shot, and other elements worked. For this shot, I applied a Photoshop Watercolor filter and adjusted the curves.
