Join State Park staff and National Park Service volunteers from the John H. Chaffee Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor to learn how to gather maple sap and make it into syrup. It's our fifth year and the program continues to expand. This year we have added a newly built sugar house.

Visitors learn the basics of sugaring including identifying maple trees, tapping techniques, and boiling the sap into syrup. You can help us tap the trees and gather the sap. The program also explains how you can start your own sugaring project at home with items you may already have and the purchase of a few inexpensive taps.
