## VOTER REGISTRATION REMINDER

The last day to register for the 2008 General Election in Massachusetts is **Wed, October 15th** 

The Massachusetts general election, 2008 will be held on November 4, 2008 throughout Massachusetts. Among the elections taking place are those for the office of President of the United States, John Kerry's seat in the Senate, all ten seats in the Massachusetts delegation to the House of Representatives, all eight seats in the Massachusetts Governor's Council, and all of the seats of the Massachusetts Senate and Massachusetts House of Representatives. There will also be three ballot questions: to eliminate the commonwealth's income tax; to prohibit greyhound racing; and to decriminalize possession of a small amount of marijuana. ### APPLE CRISP

### Ingredients

3/4 cup all-purpose flour
1/4 cup packed light brown sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup plus 2 tablespoons granulated sugar
1 stick cold butter, cut into small cubes
1 cup old fashioned oats (not quick cooking)
3 pounds apples, peeled and cut into 1/2-inch chunks
3 Tablespoons lemon juice
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

### Directions

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. In a large bowl, mix together flour, brown sugar, salt, and 2 tablespoons granulated sugar. Cut butter into flour mixture using a pastry blender or 2 knives until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Add oats, and use your hands to toss and squeeze mixture until large, moist clumps. Transfer to freezer to chill while you prepare your apples.

In another large bowl, toss apples with lemon juice, cinnamon, and remaining sugar. Transfer to a shallow 2quart baking dish and sprinkle with topping mixture. Place baking dish on a rimmed baking sheet, and bake until golden and bubbling, 55 to 65 minutes. Let cool 10 minutes before serving.
