Winter Parking: Help the Snow Crews Help You

Just a reminder of the Winter parking restrictions that are in effect from December 1st through April 1st.

There is no parking on the incoming side of Bunker Hill Road between 1:00a.m. and 6:00a.m. Also, parking along Bunker Hill Road is banned during snowfalls to allow the plows to effectively clear the road.

There is also no parking in some of the end parking lots during snowfall to allow the plow crews to more easily push the

snow off the roads. See the map below for details.

When you hear the plows, please move your cars from the driveways, so they can be plowed as well. Please help the snow removal crews do their job so everyone can have their drive cleared without undo delay.

Please, slow down when exiting the complex. Because of melting snow, ice may form on Bunker Hill Road just before the intersection with Grafton Street. Accidents have happened before.



No part of the premises, including but not limited to the parking areas and driveways, shall be used for parking or storing of commercial vehicles, unregistered vehicles or any motorized recreational vehicles longer than 20 feet.

CRANBERRY SAUCE & NUT CAKE

This is a great bread to have on hand. It's great for breakfast, brunch or a mid-afternoon snack with coffee.

Ingredients:

1/2 cup butter 1 cup granulated sugar

3 eggs

1 tsp. almond extract 2 cups flour

tsp. baking powder

1 tsp. baking soda 1/2 tsp. salt

1 cup sour cream 1 can whole cranberry sauce

1 cup chopped walnuts

Directions:

Preheat oven 350°. Grease and flour tube pan.

Cream together butter and sugar. Then beat in eggs and almond extract. Set aside. Sift together flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Add to egg mixture alternating with sour cream until smooth. Pour 1/2 batter into pan and spread with 1/2 cranberry sauce 7 walnuts. Repeat with remainder of batter, cranberry sauce and walnuts. Bake for approximately 55 minutes. Allow to cool completely before removing from pan.
