10-14 Lexington Road currently has no water intrusion.

Mosquitoes were sprayed by Central Mass Mosquito Control.

The streetlights have now all been installed. The contractors have cleaned up any debris and have re-seeded the grass areas that were impacted during the installation.

Three streetlights do not yet have power and remain dark. One is near 30 Lexington, one is behind the parking area near 47 Lexington and the last one is at the bottom of Concord. All three of these streetlights will be powered once National Grid arrives to install new power meters at the power panels. This may take a number of weeks.

National Grid still has not replaced the 3 broken in ground electrical junction boxes.

10 Lexington Road has been turned over to Marcus, Errico, Emmer and Brooks, a Braintree law firm, for foreclosure. This firm has handled collection attempts for 10 Lexington Road previously.
