**PRVA is having the complex sprayed for mosquitoes this year.**

**August 7, 2007  
Between 9:00PM and 11:00PM**

This will hopefully prevent the transmission of diseases such as Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) and West Nile Virus (WNV).

**Please close all doors and windows.**

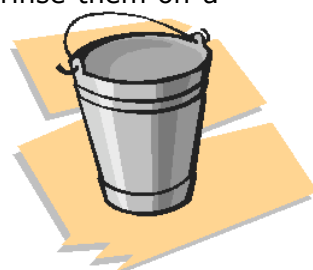
### FIGHT THE BITE

If there are any places where water collects... **you may be raising mosquitoes!**

Get rid of tin cans, bottles, jars, buckets, drums and other containers, cover them, or empty and rinse them on a weekly basis.



**Every week, you should...**

Change water and scrub vases holding flowers or cuttings; scrub and change water in bird baths; empty & rinse water pans for pets.

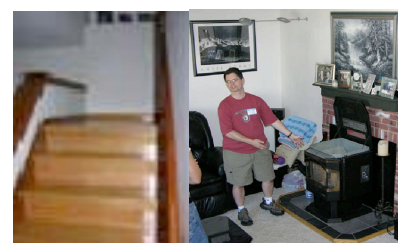
Three years ago, we held the first Home Tour for residents and their guests. All are homes are identical on the outside, but the inside....

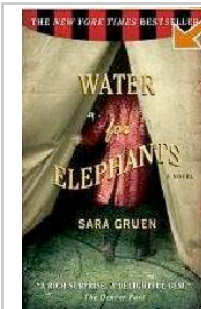
