As of this writing, 89 units have been wired for FiOS, that's 91%, which is a very good statistic. Those that have not had their units wired, will probably pay a hefty installation fee should they ever decide to subscribe to FiOS. Verizon will return the week of December 3rd to finish the outside wiring plus 5 more units have committed to the installation (which brings the total to 94 units or 96%). Most folks that I spoke with are looking forward to benefiting from FiOS (at the very least, they have some bargaining power with Charter). I am excited to experience the FiOS difference.


