Recipes - Yummy

Pumpkin Zucchini Bread- a holiday treat

- 3 Eggs; lightly beaten
- 2 c Sugar
- 1 c Mashed pumpkin
- 1 c Butter; melted
- 1 tb Vanilla
- 3 c Flour
- 1 ts Baking soda
- 1/2 ts Baking powder
- 1/2 ts Salt
- 1/2 ts Cinnamon
- 1/2 ts Ground nutmeg
- 1/2 ts Ground cloves
- 1 c Shredded zucchini
- 1 c Chopped walnuts

Preheat oven to 350°. Grease & flour 2 loaf pans.

Mix eggs and sugar; stir in pumpkin and butter. Stir dry ingredients together; add to egg mixture and mix well. Stir in zucchini and nuts. Divide into 2 loaf pans; bake 45 to 50 minutes or until test done. Cool in pans 10 minutes before removing to wire racks to cool completely.
