## We will have a **FREE** Trash Pickup Day Monday June 8

Dumpsters will be placed at the water shed for trash removal.

### 10 YARD DUMPSTER:

PAPER, PAPERBACK BOOKS (HARD COVER BOOKS MUST HAVE THE COVERS REMOVED), MAGAZINES, and CARDBOARD (must be flattened)

### 96 GALLON TOTER CARTS:

CLEAN FABRIC, CLOTHING, CURTAINS

### 30 YARD DUMPSTER:

Most household items, wood, furniture, mattresses and box springs, toys, plastic, small amounts of construction debris, toilets, sinks, countertops, doors (wood), wood windows, carpet, tile flooring, plastic patio furniture, patio umbrella with wood pole **paint cans (remove the cover and allow the paint to dry)**

### 30 YARD METAL CONTAINER:

Any item that is primarily metal (small amounts of wood, fabric, glass are ok).  
break away the *non-metal* component

ex. Lamps, office chairs, metal file cabinets, small appliances, large appliances, gas grill (without the tank), steel doors, storm doors, metal framed windows, metal patio furniture, patio umbrella with a metal pole

### ITEMS TO BE PLACED NEAR THE SHED FOR PICK UP:

Refrigerators, air conditioners, propane tanks, TVs, computer monitors, computer towers, tires, car/truck batteries, used motor oil

## 2009 is Fireplace Inspection Year!

**ALL fireplaces must be inspected and cleaned  
(if necessary)  
between April 1 and October 1**

A certificate of inspection from a licensed chimney sweep must be submitted to the Board no later than October 1, 2009. Most of our unit owners use Top Hat in Grafton. For details on a discount Top Hat is offering PRVA, call (508) 839-9997 . Fireplace cleaning and inspection is a safety issue that concerns ALL of us at PRVA.

**Homeowners and tenants are reminded that our fireplaces are NOT made to withstand continual, hot, wood fires and are NOT to be used as a primary source of heat for your unit.**

## PRVA Parking Regulations to be ENFORCED

### CRUNCHY JUMBLE COOKIES

I used to make these cookies often when I was in grade school. I've had this recipe since 8th grade home economics and I still enjoy the cookie.

- 1 1/4 cups all purpose flour
- 1/2 tsp. baking soda
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 2 cups Rice Krispies
- 1 cup chocolate chips

Preheat oven to 350°.

Mix flour, baking soda, and salt. Set aside.

Beat softened butter and sugar in a large bowl. Add egg and vanilla. Beat well. Add dry ingredients and mix well. Stir in Rice Krispies and chocolate chips.

Drop teaspoon fulls onto greased cookie sheet. Bake 350° for 10-12 minutes.

(I love the air bake cookie sheets!)
