Trash removal and recycling costs are escalating. In order to stay within budget, we must pass along any charges to those homeowners who have additional trash beyond that for which we contract.

The standard that will be used is:

Per week

(4) white 13 gallon kitchen trash bags

Or

(1) black trash bag equivalent to one 50-60 gallon barrel

Additional bags with kitchen trash will be billed at \$2.00 per bag (black bags and bags with trash other than kitchen trash will be billed according to the contents) to the homeowner. If trash collection continues to be an issue, homeowners will be required to purchase a standard garbage can from Millbury Rubbish Removal.

Recycling is mandatory at PRVA and included in our rate. Recyclables and paper are picked up on alternate Wednesdays. Recyclables *must be* washed and free of food and debris. Labels may be left on. Newspapers cannot have the plastic delivery bag on and should not be placed out in plastic bags. Cardboard boxes MUST be flattened and broken down to 24" x 36" max size. Place the juice, milk or other beverage containers that are plastic coated and have a plastic pour spout with Co-Mingled materials, not paper. REMOVE any pizza and dirty insert from pizza boxes. DO NOT recycle tissues, napkins and paper towels and dirty disposable foil pans.

Please be sure that your recyclable materials are in a container that will prohibit the wind from blowing them around the area.

Plastic:

Use, wash & co-mingle

(MUST have recycle emblem, numbered 1-7).

- Discard lid, rinse, flatten.
- Milk jugs - laundry containers
- Soda, water, juice
- NO plastic bags

Glass

- Discard lid, rinse clean
- Labels can stay on.
- ONLY glass food & beverage
— containers e.g., peanut
— butter, pickle, wine, beer.
- NO ceramic dishes/mugs,
— drinking glasses, window
— glass, light bulbs

Paper:

Use me, then stack me

- Corrugated cardboard
— (flattened)
- Newspapers and magazines
- Mixed (junk mail)
- Phone books and
— computer paper
- Cereal boxes (without liners)

Metal Cans

- Food/Drink containers only
- NO aerosol or paint cans

If recyclable materials are found to be unacceptable, they will be left at the curb for correction to the problem. If your recycling has been left, do not hesitate to contact Millbury Rubbish Removal through their website for clarification to the problem.
